



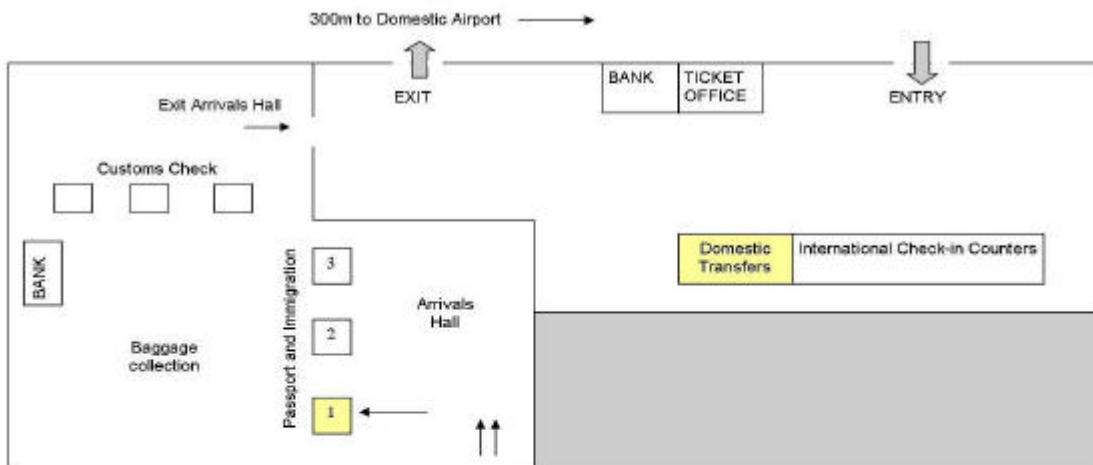
Visa Requirement

For most nationalities a 60-day Tourist Visa can be purchased on arrival into Port Moresby. (please check with your travel agent or email us for list of high risk countries which require visa prior to travel) Passports must be valid for a minimum one year after entry. Cost is K100, if necessary money can be exchanged at the bank within **arrivals**.

Baggage Allowance Air Niugini

With Air Niugini for international flights the standard allowance is 20kgs, **with an additional 15kgs for dive gear (80lbs)** – **total 35kg for divers**
International travellers connecting to domestic flights on the same-day or within 24hrs qualify for the same additional **35Kg**

PORT MORESBY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- Visa Purchase on Arrival—Passport & Immigration Desk 1. If foreign currency is not accepted you can buy Kina at the bank within the Arrivals Hall.
- Collect your baggage, pass through Customs and exit the Arrivals Hall.
- Domestic Transfer Counter—Located within this terminal at the International Check-in area. Check-in and collect your boarding pass for your domestic flight.
- Domestic Terminal—Exit the terminal and turn right towards the Domestic Airport

Domestic flights to Kavieng

If you have to overnight in Moresby a Hotel Courtesy bus will meet you at the airport.

Please check in early for your domestic connection to avoid problems with seat allocation and overbooking of flights. Transfers are provided from your hotel to the domestic terminal.

If you have a same day connection to Kavieng you can check your luggage in at the domestic transfer desk located inside the international terminal as per airport layout diagram.

Exit the international terminal turn right and proceed 300m to domestic terminal with your boarding pass.
